INSTRUCTIONS FOR TRAINERS - DO NOT PRINT!!!

- 1) Print the first page on one piece of paper and pages from 2 to 5 on a second piece of paper, printed front and back.
- 2) Distribute the first page.
- 3) Explain exercise's logic: to identify the number of fruits in each line, writing the result in the first column. At the end of the exercise, in the second column, a scoring schedule will be given with the correct answers. Ask participants if they understood the instructions.
- 4) Make sure that participants complete the practice, checking for mistakes (there isn't a time limit for this phase).
- 5) As soon as all participants have completed the training, tell them that the real test is about to begin and distribute the second paper (pages from 2 to 5)
- 6) Ask participants to work quickly and accurately and give them exactly 3 minutes to complete the exercise
- 7) At the end of every minute, ask participants to make a mark
- 8) When the time runs out, ask participants to put down their pens
- 9) On plenary setting, ask participants to compare the number of right and wrong answers made during the first minute with those made during the last one using the scoring schedule.
